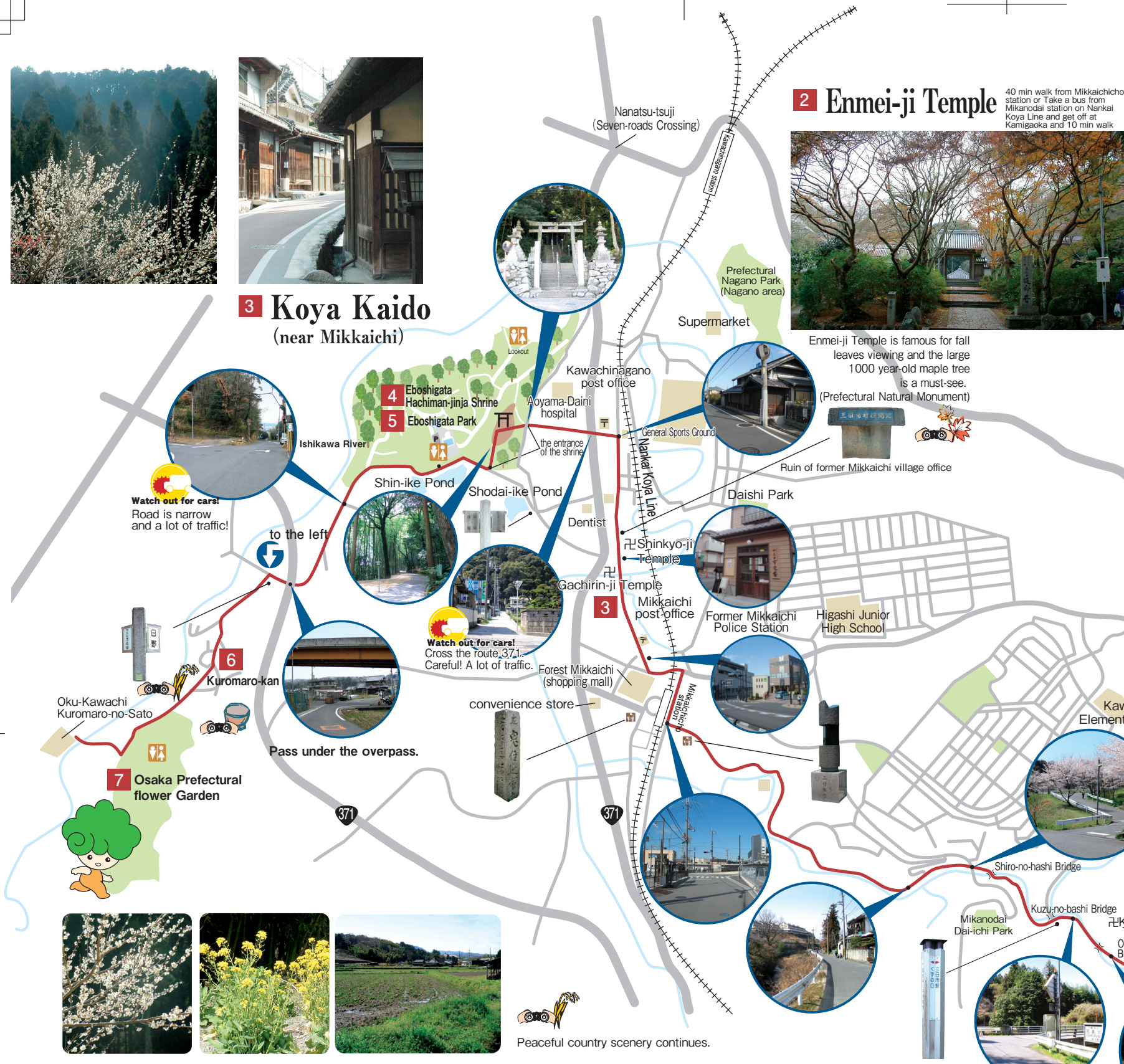


History and Flowers

1 Kanshin-ji Temple



Kondo (Golden Hall) (National Treasure) of Kanshin-ji Temple Stone steps from Kanshin-ji Temple to Emperor Gorumakami Hino-o-ryo Mausoleum

For Kanshin-ji Temple, take a bus for Kobuki-dai / Kongo-san Ropeway / Ishimigawa) at #3 bus stop at Kawachinagano station. 15 min ride and get off at Kanshin-ji. It's there.



Flower of the city "Chrysanthemum"

Chrysanthemum can be seen in the crest flag of the Kusunoki family and it symbolizes clean and modest hearts so that it was designated as the city flower on November 3rd in 1969.

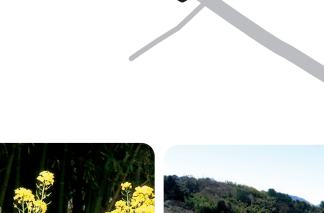

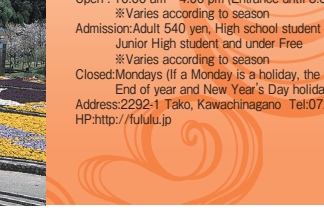
