This place was established under the concept of consuming and utilizing the local trees within the local area. So they have set up a system and now they produce "Osaka Kawachi Lumber" from local cedar and cypress trees.

3 Gyoja Yusui Chokubai-sho (Gyoja Spring Water Market)

Spring water intake spot run by local residents. It was named after En-no-gyoia, who opened sugendo, a sect of Esoteric Buddhism, and is called Gyoja Yusui. Many people visit here all year round and sometimes they need to line up for their turn on a busy day. There are many frequent visitors. There is a market next to the spot and sells preserved vegetables made from local products, shiitake mushrooms, konnyaku (hardly jelly made from the starch of devil's tongue), pickles and seasonal vegetables. Free resting place and lavatories available. ※Water intake is available 7:00 am - 5:00 pm. Open all year round. The market closes occasionally.

C Hachiman-jinja Shrine

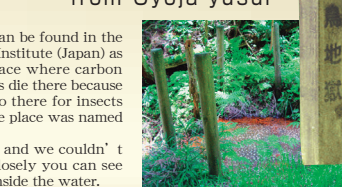
>>>About 10 min walk from Amami station

"Tori-jigoku" on Ishimi-gawa river can be found in the map issued by Geographical Survey Institute (Japan) as a name of the spot. It is a hollow place where carbon dioxide gas is accumulated and insects die there because of lack of oxygen. Then birds go into there for insects also die of suffocation. This is how the place was named as such. Now the hollow is filled with water and we couldn't see "the hell" but when observing closely you can see carbon dioxide gas bubbles up from inside the water.
